2.3 Cloud Hosting

Cloud Hosting makes applications and websites accessible using cloud resources. A network of connected virtual and physical cloud servers hosts the application or website, ensuring greater flexibility and scalability.

2.4 Cloud Hosting Platform

A vendor who offers the use of virtual hardware, network, storage and composite solutions for cloud hosting.

2.4.1 Firebase

Firebase is Google's mobile application development platform that helps you build, improve, and grow your app. Firebase is categorized as a NoSQL database program, which stores data in JSON-like documents.

2.5 Ionic Framework

An open source UI toolkit for building performant, high-quality mobile and desktop apps using technologies - HTML, CSS, and JavaScript - with integrations for popular frameworks like Angular.

2.6 Angular Platform

Combines the core Ionic experience with the tooling and APIs that are tailored to Angular Developers.

2.7 Capacitor

An open source cross-platform app runtime that allows web-based apps to run natively on iOS, Android and the web.

2.8 GitHub

A code hosting platform for version control and collaboration. This allows developers to easily collaborate, as they can download a new version of the software, make changes, and upload the newest revision.

2.9 Repository

A directory or storage space containing all your project's files and stores each file's revision history. Other developers will pull the file and sync them to their local repository and will be able to make changes.

3.0 Vagaro

A cloud-based management solution our client is using for users to schedule appointments and shop for products.
