2. Definitions

2.1 Class

The course associated with the syllabus a Student uploads into their Open Planner account.

2.2 Student

A User with an account on Open Planner.

2.3 User

Any individual visiting the Open Planner application who does not necessarily have an account

2.4 Calendar

A Student's account Calendar with a name and color that are associated to events

2.5 Event

A student's class assignment, exam or personal event

2.6 System

The underlying back-end functionality, not accessible to the Student, that handles requests from a Student's account or Admin's account and interacts with the Student/Admin accordingly

2.7 Profile

A Student's personal information, consisting of username, email, and password

2.8 Admin

A user with admin privileges on Open Planner.

2.9 Front-End

The component of the Open Planner application that Users/Students will interact with directly and submit requests through. ReactJS will be used as the library for developing this component of Open Planner.

2.10 Back-End

The component of the Open Planner application that is not accessible to Users/Students and is responsible for storing and manipulating Event and Calendar data. Python along with the Django REST Framework will be used in developing this component of Open Planner.

2.11 Master Calendar

The calendar that contains all the calendars and events associated with a Student's account. Students should be able to filter out this calendar to view certain events.

2.12 AWS

Stands for Amazon Web Services and is used to deploy Front-End and Back-End.
